## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does it mean to say “I believe in someone” (eg. Husband; Wife; Child)?
2. Read John 14:1-2. Why are the disciples “troubled”? How would knowing about the “Father’s house” ease their fears?
3. How would you explain faith in Jesus to a child or seeker?
4. How does faith address some of the anxieties we experience?
5. Read John 14:5-7. What was Thomas’ concern? What kept Thomas from seeing Jesus as “the Way, the Truth and the Life”?
6. What should it look like for Jesus to be the “Way, Truth and Life” for you?
7. Why are some people offended by what God has said is “Good News” (or, Gospel)?
8. Read John 14:8-11. What did Philip ask for? Paraphrase what Jesus said to Philip about faith (use the tone of voice you think He might have used).
9. What would it mean for Philip to really “know” Jesus (verse 9)? How about for you?
10. Read John 14:12-15. What did Jesus say those who had faith in Him would do (verse 12)? How does the church do “greater things” today?
11. How is prayer and obedience involved in doing “greater things” (verses 13-15)?
12. What “greater things” does the Lord desire to do in and through your life?
