DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How is the fear of God healthy for you? How do both worship and fear come together as we approach God?
2. Read Malachi 3:13-15. For what did God rebuke the people of Judah? How do people act the same toward God today?
3. Read Malachi 3:16-18. What was the key characteristic of those whom God “listened to and heard?” What was God’s response to the righteous?
4. What did the Lord mean by “they will be mine?” How do the Lord’s words apply to our need for urgency in sharing Christ?
5. Read Malachi 4:1-3. Contrast how the Lord will treat the “arrogant” and “every evildoer” to those who “revere” God’s name. To what degree do you see the evil punished and the righteous prosper in your world?
6. Read Malachi 4:4-6. Why is the term “remember” so prevalent throughout the Bible concerning God’s laws, warnings and promises?
7. Who fulfilled the role of Elijah in preparation for the Lord’s coming (read Matthew 11:10-14)? What was John the Baptist’s role according to Jesus?
8. Why was the Messiah’s coming a “great and dreadful day?”
9. What is the choice God has placed before the people of Judah? What is the choice God has placed before us today?
10. Who turns our hearts toward caring for others? What would happen to us this life and in the life to come if God did not transform our hearts?
11. In light of the book of Malachi, what needs to be renewed in your heart when it comes to the worship of God?
12. What can I thank God for in light of what Christ has done for me?
