Faith that Works: Faith through Obedience James 1:19-27

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Job 40:8 (NIV): "Would you discredit my justice? Would you condemn me to justify yourself?"

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

James 1:19 (NIV): ¹⁹ My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,

quick = "swift; in the next moment"

"pause for effect"

MAIN POINT: Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

James 1:20-21 (NIV): ²⁰ because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires. ²¹ Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Psalm 4:4 (ESV): Be angry, do not sin...

You will not have to take back what you did not say.

MAIN POINT: Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

James 1:22-25 (NIV): ²² Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. ²³ Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror ²⁴ and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. ²⁵ But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

MAIN POINT: Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

James 1:26-27 (NIV): ²⁶ Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless. ²⁷ Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Ephesians 4:29 (NIV): ²⁹ Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

religion = "ceremonial observance; worship"

MAIN POINT: Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.
