- 3. Read vv. 4-7. How is the prophecy of Jeremiah "inspired" differently than other books or histories of his day (or, for today)?
- 4. What do you think it means to "turn from (our) wicked ways" (vv. 3;7)? Why is repentance important for our relationship with God?

- 10. What are the results of ignoring/denying the Bible's authority in our world or our lives?
