1. How would you like to be remembered at your funeral? How is that going for you? What needs to happen to make that vision a reality?
2. Read Acts 16:5. What is happening in the churches that Paul, Silas and Timothy are ministering in? How would such results affect morale in the fellowships?
3. How is the Holy Spirit leading according to verse 6 and 7? What do they do in response to God’s direction (see verse 8)?
4. When you experience a “closed door” in regards to God’s leading, how do you handle it? How can God’s road blocks be to your advantage in terms of greater impact?
5. Read Acts 16:9-10. What does Paul conclude after envisioning the man from Macedonia’s request? Why do you think this was such a compelling revelation to him?
6. How does a call like this change everything? What do you find motivating from Pastor Craig’s message about Westside’s vision to “connect this generation to Christ and His church”?
7. In verse 10, when does the team respond to God’s direction? What does their immediate obedience have to say to us about responding to God’s call?
8. What are some of the other ways that God might use to lead His servants toward greater impact?
9. What is one thing you need to do this week to make yourself more responsive to God’s vision/will?
