Anxious For Nothing

John 2:23-3:17

- 1. Share with the group a time you did something just to impress others.
- 2. Read John 2:23-25. Why did the people believe in Jesus? Explain the depth of their faith. How can we know if we have a deep faith?
- 3. Why did Jesus not entrust himself to the people? What does this say about humanity and our own fallen nature?
- 4. Read John 3:1-2. Why did Nicodemus come to Jesus at night? Why is there sometimes a temptation to hide our full commitment to Jesus?
- 5. Is it possible to secretly follow Jesus (see John 19:38-39)? Explain why or why not.
- 6. Read John 3:3-8. Jesus is not interested in Nicodemus' words of flattery and instead cuts right to the heart of the issue. What does Jesus mean by "born again?"
- 7. Why was Nicodemus having a difficult time understanding Jesus? In what ways do you struggle to understand God's will?
- 8. Read John 3:9-15. Jesus patiently walks Nicodemus through his questions and doubt. How does this reflect the heart of our heavenly Father?
- 9. Jesus' willingness to patiently minister to Nicodemus is a great model for how we interact with others. How does this inform the way we share the Gospel?
- 10. Read John 3:16-17. In your own words, describe what these verses teach us. How does God's promise for eternal life take on a richer reality in the face of this pandemic?
- 11. What piece of hope from this passage do you and your family need to hold onto this week?
