DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Do you think you learned about the birds and the bees at an appropriate age? Why or why not?

2. How do most of those in your world view adultery (immoral, nothing wrong with it, the unforgivable sin)?

3. Why is preaching or teaching on sexuality uncomfortable for many within the church? Should it be taught on in the church? Why or why not?

4. Read Exodus 20:14. What does this command teach us?

5. Read Matthew 5:27-28 and 5:31-32. How does Jesus' teaching here help us to understand God's heart when it comes to adultery?

6. How does being faithful to God look in the area of sexuality for a single person (never married, divorced or widowed)?

7. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20. What does it look like to "flee from sexual immorality?" What is unique about sexual sin when compared to other sins?

8. What do these verses use as motivation for being holy when it comes to sexuality?

9. How is the "damage radius" greater for some sexual sin versus other sexual sin (i.e. rape, lust, pornography, adultery, fornication, homosexuality, etc.)? When have you witnessed the damage adultery brings?

10. How does the gospel compel you to live a faithful life for God? How does living faithfully for God when it comes to sex impact one's witness for Christ?

11. How can someone who has disobeyed God's Word when it comes to sexuality be restored (see 1 John 1:9)? How can you help a friend who has fallen into sexual sin?

12. What can you do this week in order to be faithful to God with all of your being?
