DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are some blessings to doing church online?
2. **Read Esther 4:14.** What does it mean for us to be here “for such a time as this?”
3. **Read Mark 14:27-31.** Describe the shock the disciples must have felt when Jesus told them they would all fall away.
4. Based upon their response, does it seem like they got the point that Jesus said he would rise from the dead? In verse 28, how is Jesus letting the disciples know He’s got this even though He knew what they would do?
5. Why would Peter “argue” with Jesus, and in essence, tell Jesus He was wrong? In what ways do we do the same thing?
6. **Read Mark 14:50.** How does this verse inform verse 31?
7. **Read Mark 14:54.** Why did Peter follow Jesus at a distance? Are you following Jesus from a distance?
8. **Read Mark 14:66-72.** Why is there such a contrast between what Peter promised and what he did? How can you relate to Peter?
9. Why did Peter break down and weep? Why is repentance a necessary spiritual act?
10. **Read Luke 22:61.** What do you think Jesus was communicating to Peter when He looked at him?
11. **Read John 21:15-22.** How did Jesus display grace and mercy to Peter? What did Jesus call Peter to do?
12. Why would Peter ask about John’s call? Why does self-comparison sometimes distract us from the will of God?
13. What are some practical steps you can take to keep your eyes on Jesus?
