

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Who was the best (or, worst) boss you ever worked for?
- 2. What signs of hope do you detect as the chapter opens in verses 1-3? What do Ruth and Naomi need to have happen in order to survive?
- 3. Is it a "coincidence" that Ruth ends up by Naomi's relative's field (verse 3)? What's the difference between coincidence and God's providence? How has God demonstrated His providential care in your life?

- 4. Read verses 4-10. How is the Lord working to meet Ruth and Naomi's needs?
- 5. What kind of man/boss do you think Boaz was (hint: his name means "in him is strength")? Why do you suppose he noticed Ruth? When have you sensed "Gods favor" in the tasks/ministries He has called you to?
- 6. Read verses 10-13. What character qualities did Boaz see in Ruth? How is Boaz's desire to bless Ruth, evidence of God's presence/priority in Ruth's life? How can you be a "blessing" to those you have influence over?
- 7. In verses 14-18, we see God providing for Ruth and Naomi with abundance (food for possibly a week and a half). Is there a specific time that you can remember God coming through for you in your journey?
- 8. Read verses 19-23. As Ruth and Naomi review what happened, what do you think they are feeling?
- 9. How is their "plan" both logical and hopeful? What lessons can we glean (pun intended) from them regarding seeking Gods providential will for our lives?
- 10. What divine appointment does God have for you in this season of life? How will you act on them? Pray and act!
