DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Were you told to not associate with some people when you were young? If so, do agree with what you were told?
2. Read John 4:1-9. What barriers did Jesus break through by simply asking this woman for a drink of water from her cup? What barriers were overcome by those who led you to Christ?
3. How can we be on mission for Christ even when we are hot, tired, thirsty, hungry or hurting? How often have you neglected to share Christ with someone who needed him?
4. Read John 4:10-15. How did Jesus' illustration about "thirst" lead this woman into a spiritual conversation about her real need?
5. What did the woman want? What did the woman need? How can we communicate the real need to those in our world who are so focused upon their wants and do not even see their need?
6. Read John 4:16-26. How did Jesus point out this woman's sin, yet still communicate grace and mercy to her? How can you apply Jesus' example when sharing your faith?
7. How did this woman deflect the conversation about her sin toward a theological discussion? How can talking about theology deflect from facing our sin?
8. What does it look like to worship the Father in Spirit and in truth? To what degree do you worship God in Spirit and in truth?
9. Read John 4:28-30. Upon encountering Jesus, what do the woman's actions reveal about her heart?
10. Read John 4:39-42. What fruit did the Lord produce through this woman? What fruit can the Holy Spirit produce through you?
11. Is your spiritual well flowing with living water or has it run dry? How can we help to quench people's spiritual thirst?
