- 1. What was your relationship with your father like growing up? What happens when the relationship between a child and parent matures?
- 2. How has your relationship with your earthly father impacted your view of God as your Heavenly Father?
- 3. Read Isaiah 9:6-7. What does the literal translation of "Everlasting Father," meaning "Forever Father," communicate? What does having a Forever Father mean for you?
- 4. Read Isaiah 49:15-16. Can a baby live without someone else caring for his or her basic needs? How does verse 15 speak to us about having God's hand upon our lives?
- 5. What does verse 16 communicate about God the Father's love for you? How does your understanding of the Father's love for you compel you to worship him?
- 6. Read Matthew 7:7-11. Sadly, there are abusive, neglectful and absent parents, but would you ever give any child a stone to eat?
- 7. Why does Jesus call earthly fathers "evil?" Does that offend you? Why or why not?
- 8. What was the greatest gift your parents ever gave you? Why do you still remember that particular gift?
- 9. Do you view God as a Forever Father who desires to give you "good gifts?" Please explain.
- 10. What is the greatest gift your Forever Father has given you? How does this gift help you believe that he loves you and will care for your needs forever?
- 11. How does your view of God's goodness impact your willingness to ask him for your heart's desire, and to trust him no matter what his answer is to your request?
- 12. What is the Holy Spirit compelling you to ask of God the Father now? Who in your life needs to hear about the Father's love this Christmas?
