- 4. **Read Hebrews 4:3.** What is the "rest" God provides those who are followers of Christ? How does this rest parallel the "home" Naomi sought for Ruth to have?
- 5. **Read Ruth 3:2-6.** Describe what Naomi was trying to get Ruth to do. Do Naomi's instructions seem morally questionable to you? Why or why not?
- 6. How does Ruth's response to Naomi illustrate her attitude of humility? Why is humility so pivotal in your relationship with God?
- 7. Describe a time in which you felt led to step out in faith. How does stepping out in faith ultimately teach us to rest in God?
- 8. **Read Ruth 3:7-9**. What was Ruth really asking of Boaz? What do you think was going through both Ruth and Boaz's minds?
- 9. Describe a time in which you witnessed bold faith in someone else. How did that person's radical faith impact you?
- 10. How is learning to rest in God the ultimate act of faith?
- 11. What is one area that God is calling you to step out in faith in this season of your life?
