- 5. Read Philemon 1:8-14. On what basis does Paul appeal to Philemon? Why is Paul so passionate that Philemon's base motivation is love instead of compulsion?
- 6. Read verses 15-16. Paul wants Onesimus to be accepted back as a 'dear brother'. Why was this such a radical advice at the time?
- 7. Read Philemon 1:17-19. Paul offers to repay any debt Onesimus has. How does Paul's heart for Onesimus mirror God's heart for us?
- 8. Read verse 21. How do you think Philemon actually responded when Onesimus came home?
- 9. Are there consequences for holding unforgiveness towards someone? What are the consequences to a family? What are the consequences to a church?
- 10. How does understanding our own forgiveness in Jesus help us forgive and restore others?

Big Idea: Allow the Gospel to live in you FULLY so that God is able to use you to RESTORE others.
