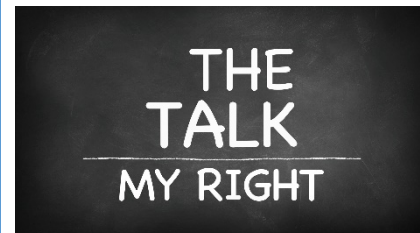


LIFE GROUPS

1. What is the most memorable advertisement you can remember?

3. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:12.** What does this say about the culture in Corinth? What are some similarities to the current American culture?
4. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:13.** What is God's design for sexuality? What consequences have you observed in our world for those who step outside of God's design?
5. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:14.** What does this passage teach us about God's plan for our bodies? Is this power still available to us today?
6. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:15-17.** Why does the Apostle Paul use such a shocking metaphor? What does this communicate about the importance of God's plan for sexuality?
7. Culture teaches us that sex is a purely physical act. What does Scripture teach us?
8. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:18.** What does it mean to "flee from sexual immorality?" What are some real-life examples of fleeing?
9. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.** What does it mean for your body to be a "temple of the Holy Spirit?" How does the presence of the Holy Spirit impact our daily lives?
10. What price was paid for us? How does Jesus' death help set us free from sexual immorality?
11. How does understanding our identity in Christ help us live out God's design for sexuality and to empower us to overcome sexual temptation?
12. **Reread 1 Corinthians 6:12.** What are some ways you can be built up in your faith? What can you do this week to be stronger against the temptation of sexual immorality?
