Why Christmas? Jesus is Divine John 1:1-5

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

2 Timothy 4:1-2 (NIV): In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge: ² Preach the word...

logos = word; divine reason

MAIN POINT: Preach the Word!

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

John 1:1-2 (NIV): In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

John 20:31 (NIV): ³¹ But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

MAIN POINT: Preach the Word!

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

John 1:3 (NIV): ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Genesis 1:1 (NIV): In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

MAIN POINT: Preach the Word!

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

John 1:4-5 (NIV): ⁴In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. ⁵The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Genesis 1:2-4 (NIV): ² Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. ³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ⁴ God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

John 8:12 (NIV): "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

John 9:5-7 (NIV): ⁵ While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." ⁶ After saying this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. ⁷ "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means "Sent"). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.

MAIN POINT: Preach the Word!
