4. Read John 18:36-37. What was Jesus’ mission? Why does the world need truth?
5. Read John 18:38. What was Pontius Pilate’s response to Jesus? How would you respond to Pilate’s question?
6. A friend of yours tells you they believe ‘truth is relative’. They also say that there are many ways to God. How would you respond to them?
7. What happens if believers compromise truth?
8. Read Ephesians 4:15. What is this passage commanding us to do?
9. Do you have a more difficult time ‘speaking the truth’ or ‘speaking in love’? Why is speaking both truth and love so difficult?
10. Ephesians 4:15 says to ‘speak truth in love’. Why is it important to speak truth in love?
11. What is a Biblical truth that is not popular today? How would you communicate that truth in love?
