DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read John 3:16-17. What does it mean to be “saved?” Do you know you are saved? If you are saved, please share how you came to Christ.
2. Read 1 John 5:11-13. Have you ever doubted you were truly a Christian? How can you know you are a Christian?
3. What keeps us from enjoying our salvation?
4. Have you been taught that you can “lose” your salvation? What do the following verses imply when it comes to what your salvation depends upon?
 - a. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22
 - b. Ephesians 2:8-10
 - c. Philippians 1:6
 - d. 1 Corinthians 3:10-15
5. Read Philippians 2:12-13. What does it mean to “work out your salvation with fear and trembling” if our salvation is based upon what Christ has done through grace alone?
6. What hinders you from investing, inviting, sharing your faith and letting people know you are a Christian?
7. Read 1 Peter 3:15-18. What is the hope we have? How can we prepare to give an answer for the hope we have?
8. How does Christ’s sacrifice compel you to share your faith? How have Christians suffered for Christ? How have you suffered because you were a Christian?
9. What are some ways you can “invest” in those who are not Christians?
10. Read Matthew 10:16-20. Why do Christians often spend most of their time as sheep among sheep rather than sheep among wolves?
11. Who saves people (you, the church or the Holy Spirit)? Who can God use to bring people to Christ? What encouragement do verses 19-20 bring you when it comes to sharing your faith?
12. Will you commit to investing in and inviting one person to church this month? To whom will you be accountable?
