Second Chances: He Came for the Least Mark 1:35-45

MAIN POINT: Jesus is able and willing to save you.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:35 (CSB): ³⁵ Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he got up, went out, and made his way to a deserted place; and there he was praying.

What is the source of Jesus' power?

prayer

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Ephesians 6:18 (CSB): ¹⁸ Pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

1 Thessalonians 5:17-18 (CSB): ¹⁷ pray constantly, ¹⁸ give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:36-39 (CSB): ³⁶ Simon and his companions searched for him, ³⁷ and when they found him they said, "Everyone is looking for you." ³⁸ And he said to them, "Let's go on to the neighboring villages so that I may preach there too. This is why I have come." ³⁹ He went into all of Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and driving out demons.

MAIN POINT: Jesus is able and willing to save you.

What is the source of Jesus' power?

Jesus prioritized and persisted in his purpose.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Mark 2:17 (CSB): 17 When Jesus heard this, he told them, "It is not those who are

well who need a doctor, but those who are sick. I didn't come to call the righteous, but sinners."

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Acts 2:41-42 (CSB): ⁴¹ So those who accepted his message were baptized, and that day about three thousand people were added to them. ⁴² They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer.

MAIN POINT: Jesus is able and willing to save you.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:40-41 (CSB): ⁴⁰ Then a man with leprosy came to him and, on his knees, begged him, "If you are willing, you can make me clean." ⁴¹ Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched him. "I am willing," he told him. "Be made clean."

moved with compassion: to be moved inwardly; to yearn with tender mercy, affection, pity, and empathy. It is the very seat of a man's affections. It is the deepest movement of emotions possible, being touched with the deepest feelings possible. It is being moved within the deepest part of a person's being.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

1 Peter 5:7 (CSB): 7 casting all your cares on him, because he cares about you.

MAIN POINT: Jesus is able and willing to save you.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:42-45 (CSB): ⁴² Immediately the leprosy left him, and he was made clean. ⁴³ Then he sternly warned him and sent him away at once, ⁴⁴ telling him, "See that you say nothing to anyone; but go and show yourself to the priest, and offer what Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." ⁴⁵ Yet he went out and began to proclaim it widely and to spread the news, with the result that Jesus could no longer enter a town openly. But he was out in deserted places, and they came to him from everywhere.
