- 3. Read John 2:23-24. What do these verses communicate is in the heart of human beings?
- 4. Read John 3:1-9. Why do you think Nicodemus, a religious authority, went to speak to Jesus? Why at night?
- 5. What did Jesus know Nicodemus needed? What does it mean to be "born again?"
- 6. Read John 3:10-18. What kept Nicodemus from understanding what Jesus said? Do you think Jesus was harsh with him? Do ever feel that Jesus is too harsh with you?
- 7. How would you explain John 3:16-18 to someone who is not a Christ-follower?
- 8. How does "believing" change someone's life?
- 9. Read John 7:32 and 7:45-52. What do these verses reveal about Nicodemus' boldness? Would you be willing to take that kind of a risk on Jesus' behalf?
- 10. Read John 19:38-42. What do these verses indicate about Nicodemus' desire to honor Jesus? What are some ways that we can honor Jesus today?
- 11. How has this study challenged you spiritually (to be born again, to be grateful for eternal life, to share the gospel)?
