- 1. What are some topics Americans are uncomfortable discussing? Why does the church not teach on God's will for sexuality more?
- 2. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:13.** Please describe the meaning of this verse in your own words.
- 3. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.** What was the "price" referring to in verse 20? How did Jesus honor the Father with His body? How does understanding the Gospel help us to honor God with our bodies?
- 4. **Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-2.** What guidelines does Paul give us for sexual morality? Why does God give us limits when it comes to sexuality?
- 5. **Read 1 Corinthians 7:3-5.** What instructions does this passage give to married couples?
- 6. A study by Insider.com (Canela Lopez, January 2020) states that "...couples who live together before getting married reported lower rates of sexual satisfaction than those who did not." How does living God's way set us up for greater fulfillment in life?
- 7. Sexual immorality can be defined as "Sexual satisfaction outside of a marriage between one man and one woman for life." Why is this seen as offensive by our culture today?
- 8. **Read John 8:1-11.** What does this woman deserve? How does Jesus treat this woman? How does this communicate God's love for you?
- 9. A friend of yours struggles with guilt and shame surrounding his or her sexual history. What counsel would you give your friend?
- 10. Members of the LGBT community are at a higher risk for suicide. What steps can we as the church take to love the LGBT community without compromising Biblical truth?
- 11. **Read 1 Corinthians 7:6-9.** Describe how singleness is a blessing. Why does much of our culture believe that those who are single are missing out on the good life?
- 12. Why does verse 9 shock some people? What does it look like for you to live out a godly sexuality regardless of your circumstances?
