DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The Westminster Shorter Catechism states, “the chief end of man is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever.” Put this statement into your own words. Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Please explain.
2. Define the term “worship.”
3. Read Psalm 95. Describe what worship should look like according to this passage. How does the worship at Westside compare to what is described in Psalm 95?
4. Verses 1 and 2 describe shouting with joy and thanksgiving as necessary components of worship. What keeps someone from experiencing joy and expressing thanksgiving when they worship?
5. Discuss the connection between knowing God, remembering his faithfulness, trusting him, and worship with rest.
6. Read Romans 12:1. What are some ways you can worship God in your everyday life?
7. Why are many Christians so focused upon the “style” of worship they like? Why would some Christ-followers think their preferred “style” is “more holy” than other styles?
8. John 4:24. What does it look like to “worship God in the Spirit and in truth?”
9. Read 1 Corinthians 1:31, 2 Corinthians 10:17 and Galatians 6:14. What do these verses command us to do?
10. Read Hebrews 10:23-25. Have you heard people say, “I do not need to go to church to be a Christian?” How would you respond to a friend who would say this?
11. Is worship (corporate and personal) an option? How important is worship to Westside Church? To you?
12. Does the Bible give one specific order of worship? If not, how is a church to decide the order of worship?
13. Do you worship with your family at home and at church? What example do you set for your family and others?
14. How can you prepare on Saturday for worship on Sunday? Are you committed to faithfully attend worship at Westside Church?
