DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are your memories of nasty storms in your lifetime? How do storms affect you positively or negatively?
2. How are storms a good metaphor for crises in the Christian life? Give some examples of types of storms that believers experience.
3. Read Mark 6:45-52. What was the problem the disciples encountered in this passage? How do you think they felt? Have you ever had similar feelings?
4. What does this story tell us about Jesus' concern for His followers?
5. Why did Jesus send His disciples into the storm if he already knew the outcome (vv. 45, 46)? What are the Lord's purposes in our storms?
6. Why do you think Jesus walked to them, and by them, on the water (v. 48)?
7. How did the Lord respond to the disciples' needs (vv. 48-52)? What did His presence mean for them?
8. What did the disciples' response of "amazement" in vv. 51,52 reveal about their understanding of who Jesus was?
9. What does His presence and concern mean for you in your storms?
10. How can you bring glory to God when you face storms?
