## SIGNIFICANT: Seek Jonah 2

### **MAIN POINT:** Give thanks for God's grace and purpose in your life.

### MAIN SCRIPTURE:

**Jonah 1:17-2:1 (NIV):** <sup>17</sup> Now the LORD provided a huge fish to swallow Jonah, and Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights. <sup>1</sup>From inside the fish Jonah prayed to the LORD his God.

- **<u>SLIDE:</u>** Prayer is the instrument God uses to bring us into closer relationship with him.
- **SLIDE:** "To concentrate so much on what happened inside the fish is to miss what happened inside Jonah... which is a great mistake."-JM Boice

### **MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Jonah 2:2 (NIV):** <sup>2</sup> He said: "In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me. From deep in the realm of the dead I called for help, and you listened to my cry.

**<u>SLIDE:</u>** In desperation Jonah prayed and God delivered him.

**MAIN POINT:** Give thanks for God's grace and purpose in your life.

### MAIN SCRIPTURE

Jonah 2:3-4 (NIV): <sup>3</sup>You hurled me into the depths, into the very heart of the seas, and the currents swirled about me; all your waves and breakers swept over me. <sup>4</sup>I said, 'I have been banished from your sight; yet I will look again toward your holy temple.'

<u>SLIDE:</u> True gratitude acknowledges God's unique power to bring about everything he wills.

#### SUPPORT SCRIPTURE

**Hebrews 12:5-6, 11 (NIV):** <sup>5</sup>"My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, <sup>6</sup> because the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son. <sup>11</sup> No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

<u>SLIDE</u>: We can despise discipline, be discouraged by it, resist it, or submit to it for its intended purposes.

## MAIN SCRIPTURE:

**Jonah 2:5-7 (NIV):** The engulfing waters threatened me, the deep surrounded me; seaweed was wrapped around my head. <sup>6</sup> To the roots of the mountains I sank down; the earth beneath barred me in forever. But you, LORD my God, brought my life up from the pit. <sup>7</sup> "When my life was ebbing away, I remembered you, LORD, and my prayer rose to you, to your holy temple.

## MAIN SCRIPTURE

**Jonah 2:8-10 (NIV):** <sup>8</sup>"Those who cling to worthless idols turn away from God's love for them. <sup>9</sup> But I, with shouts of grateful praise, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good. I will say, 'Salvation comes from the LORD.'" <sup>10</sup> And the LORD commanded the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry land.

# SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

**Matthew 12:40 (NIV):** <sup>40</sup> For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
