DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does it mean to “praise” something or someone?
2. What receives most of your praise? What deserves the most praise?
3. How do you measure what is worthy of praise?
4. How do you “praise” the Lord beyond singing at church?
5. Read Psalm 103:1-5. What does it look like for you to praise the Lord with all of your being?
6. Why does God call us to praise Him? Does He NEED our praise? Do you NEED to praise Him?
7. The Westminster Shorter Catechism that teaches the whole duty of a human being is “to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.” How does your life align with this statement?
8. List some “benefits” the Lord has provided you (see v. 2). What does it mean to have ALL of your sins forgiven (v. 3)?
9. Describe the contrast of being in the pit of hell for all eternity to being in the presence of the Lord in glory forever as a crowned prince/princess of God Almighty (see v. 4).
10. Share a time when God did not provide what you asked for, but what you needed (v. 5).
11. How does praising the Lord change our perspective on life?
12. What needs to change in your life in giving God praise?
