DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were you most afraid of as a child? Now?
2. Read Mark 4:35-41. Where did Jesus tell the disciples that they were going (vv. 35, 36)? Should they have doubted His Word/concern (v.38)? Explain.
3. Why do you think Jesus' followers were surprised in vv. 37, 38? Have you ever drawn similar conclusions to the "storms" of trial in your life (eg. sickness; loss; financial need; relational friction)? What helped you most in navigating the storm?
4. Would you consider verse 38 a prayer of sorts in response to a sleeping Jesus? Have you ever "prayed" similarly?
5. How does Jesus "solve" the problem (v.39)? In what ways has the Lord met your needs in the middle of storms?
6. In verse 40, why did Jesus rebuke the twelve (or more)? What can be learned from His correction?
7. Describe the disciple's response to the Lord's miracle over nature (v.41)? What did they learn?
8. Contrast the "fear" or awe experienced in verse 41 with the "fear" they previously had in the storm? What is the result of "fear of the Lord"?
9. How can you trust more completely in the power and authority of Jesus? How does the fact that Jesus being fully human help you to relate to Him?
10. What fear(s) do you need to surrender to the Lord this week?
