



**MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 2:6-7 (CSB):** <sup>6</sup> But some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts: <sup>7</sup> “Why does he speak like this? He’s blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?”

**MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 2:8-9 (CSB):** <sup>8</sup> Right away Jesus perceived in his spirit that they were thinking like this within themselves and said to them, “Why are you thinking these things in your hearts? <sup>9</sup> Which is easier: to say to the paralytic, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up, take your mat, and walk’?”

**MAIN POINT:**

**Receive the forgiveness Jesus alone provides.**

**MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Mark 2:10-12 (CSB):** <sup>10</sup> But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins”—he told the paralytic— <sup>11</sup> “I tell you: get up, take your mat, and go home.” <sup>12</sup> Immediately he got up, took the mat, and went out in front of everyone. As a result, they were all astounded and gave glory to God, saying, “We have never seen anything like this!”

**Your faith should bring glory to God.**

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Acts 4:12 (CSB):** <sup>12</sup> “There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.”

**MAIN POINT:**

**Receive the forgiveness Jesus alone provides.**
