Second Chances: An Unlikely Messenger Mark 1:1-13

MAIN POINT: Announce Jesus as the Good News.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Mark 10:45 (NIV): ⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:1 (NIV): The beginning of the good news about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God,

What is the "good news" or "gospel"?

euangelion is the "good news" about the salvation God has provided through Jesus Christ.

MAIN POINT: Announce Jesus as the Good News.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:2-3 (NIV): ² as it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way"—³ "a voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.'"

MAIN POINT: Announce Jesus as the Good News.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:4-8 (NIV): ⁴ And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. ⁵ The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. ⁶ John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. ⁷ And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. ⁸ I baptize you with ^[g] water, but he will baptize you with ^[f] the Holy Spirit."

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:9-11 (NIV): ⁹ At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. ¹⁰ Just as Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. ¹¹ And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

Why was Jesus baptized?

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Mark 10:38 (NIV): ³⁸ "You don't know what you are asking," Jesus said. "Can you drink the cup I drink or be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with?"

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Romans 6:3 (NIV): ³ Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Isaiah 42:1 (NIV): "Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations.

MAIN POINT: Announce Jesus as the Good News.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 1:12-13 (NIV): ¹² At once the Spirit sent him out into the wilderness, ¹³ and he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. He was with the wild animals, and angels attended him.

MAIN POINT: Announce Jesus as the Good News.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Hebrews 4:15 (NIV): ¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.
