- 2. **Read Haggai 2:10-14.** How long has it been since Haggai's 1<sup>st</sup> message? What inferences can you draw about the attitudes and/or the quality of the work?

- 3. How did the people view their efforts to rebuild the temple? How did they think God viewed their efforts? Does God receive their efforts as holy (verse 14)? Explain.
- 4. **Read Psalms 24:3-4.** How can we identify when our engagement in religious activity is not pleasing to God?
- 5. In light of God's reminder of his covenant in Haggai 2:5, why would he refer to them as "this people" and "this nation" and not as "my chosen people"?
- 6. **Read Haggai 2:15-19.** What was God asking the laborers to "give careful thought" to? What were their lives like before they began the work of rebuilding the temple?
- 7. Why did God withhold his blessing from their lives?
- 8. What is God directing them to give careful thought to in verses 18 and 19? Since the crops have just been planted, how does Haggai assure them of God's blessing?
- 9. **Read 1 Peter 2:9-10.** When we make God's blessings the priority, what does that blessing look like?
- 10. This week, how can you demonstrate a God-honoring concern and commitment to the building of Christ's church?
