DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share about a Christmas when you received a gift that was way beyond what you thought you would receive. How does this parallel God's gift of eternal life?
2. Read Habakkuk 2:20. How is silence before the Lord a precursor to worship of the Lord? What happens in us and to us as we are silent before the Lord?
3. Read Habakkuk 3:1-2. How does experiencing or hearing about God's great miracles in the world inspire you? What miracle would you want God to do in your life today?
4. Explain what Habakkuk must have meant by, "In wrath, remember mercy" (verse 2).
5. Read Habakkuk 3:3-12. What picture does Habakkuk paint of God's work and power in these verses?
6. Compare the Sun, moon, oceans, and mountains in size when compared to human beings. How do these verses humble and encourage you?
7. Read Habakkuk 3:13-16. What is God's motivation in displaying his power? Is it an ego trip?
8. Why would Habakkuk still want the destruction of the Babylonians, yet not want his own people to suffer even though both peoples disobeyed the Lord? To what degree can you relate to Habakkuk's reaction?
9. Read Habakkuk 3:17-19. How can Habakkuk rejoice in the Lord in tough times?
10. When have you experienced an intimate time in prayer and/or worship while you were going through a difficult season in life? How did being in God's presence change your perspective?
11. Read Mark 8:34-36. How does Jesus' question in verse 36 challenge you? Why is an eternal perspective necessary to live faithfully for God?
12. How can you worship the Lord this week because of who He is not because you have everything you want?
