



**MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Jonah 3:5-6 (NIV):** <sup>5</sup>The Ninevites believed God. A fast was proclaimed, and all of them, from the greatest to the least, put on sackcloth.

<sup>6</sup>When Jonah's warning reached the king of Nineveh, he rose from his throne, took off his royal robes, covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the dust.

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Isaiah 55:11 (NIV):** <sup>11</sup>so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

**MAIN POINT:**

**MAIN SCRIPTURE:**

**Jonah 3:7-9 (NIV):** <sup>7</sup>This is the proclamation he issued in Nineveh: "By the decree of the king and his nobles: Do not let people or animals, herds or flocks, taste anything; do not let them eat or drink. <sup>8</sup>But let people and animals be covered with sackcloth. Let everyone call urgently on God. Let them give up their evil ways and their violence. <sup>9</sup>Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish."

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 16:17 (NIV):** <sup>17</sup>Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven."

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Matthew 26:75 (NIV):** <sup>75</sup>Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: "Before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**John 21:17 (NIV):** Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, “Do you love me?” He said, “Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you.” Jesus said, “Feed my sheep.”

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Acts 2:41 (NIV):** <sup>41</sup> Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

**SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:**

**Acts 9:43 (NIV):** <sup>43</sup> Peter stayed in Joppa for some time with a tanner named Simon.

**Jonah 3:10 (NIV):** <sup>10</sup> When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he relented and did not bring on them the destruction he had threatened.
