DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share a time when you felt great delight when you gave generously.
2. Why does giving bring delight to us? Why would giving NOT bring us delight?
3. Read Acts 20:35. To what degree do you believe Jesus' words? Why is it such a challenge to always believe and live out these words?
4. Read 2 Chronicles 24:1-3. How many of us would have the wisdom to lead a nation at 7 years of age (or 18 years of age for that matter)?
5. Who has been a great mentor in your life? Why do mentors matter?
6. Read 2 Chronicles 24:4-7. King Joash sensed God call him to restore the temple. Why did the temple restoration not happen right away? When have you felt God's work take time in your life?
7. Read 2 Chronicles 24:8-11. Why did the people "gladly" bring contributions to the temple restoration if this was a tax?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7. Describe the difference of the call of a New Testament Christian in bringing tithes and offerings to the Lord versus an Old Testament call to pay a tax. How is giving generously to the Lord an opportunity versus a burden?
9. Read 2 Chronicles 24:12-14. The Israelites provided plenty of funds to keep the temple operating continually. How does this passage relate to Christ's ministry through the local church (i.e. Westside)?
10. Read 2 Chronicles 24:15-16. Scripture communicates the "good he [Jehoiada] had done in Israel for God and his temple." What should we desire for our impact to be upon our community and church at the end of our days?
11. Do you believe your impact is what it should be for your community and church? What needs to change?
