- 1. What is your definition of failure? What causes a person to feel like a failure?
- 2. **Read 2 Samuel 7:16 and Haggai 2:19.** Will God keep his word? How can God's word turn someone who feels like a failure into someone who is a winner?

- 3. **Read Haggai 2:20-23**. Six times in these verses God says "I will." What does this tell us about the world in which we live? Is God's direct involvement a source of comfort or fear? Why?
- 4. How would these statements give Zerubbabel and the people he leads, confidence that God's plan would prevail?
- 5. What current challenges did the Israelites face that made it difficult to be encouraged and trust God? Does God appear to be concerned about how history would unfold?
- 6. Why is it important to Zerubbabel to know that he has been "chosen" by God?
- The three purposes of a signet ring are 1) personal signature of a king 2) validated royal authority 3) guarantee to fulfill a future promise. Read Ephesians 1:12-14. How do these verses and these purposes apply to the life of a Christian?
- 8. Explain how Jesus is our ultimate signet ring.
- 9. **Read Jeremiah 22:24-27**. With Zerubbabel, God graciously reversed the judgment on his grandfather and restored the Davidic throne. Would you rather experience earthly glory or eternal glory? Explain.
- 10. What can we learn about the work of the church today from the book of Haggai?
- 11. When you face challenges, how can you know that the promises given over a thousand years ago will be fulfilled? What assurances do you have that those promises are true?
