## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Describe what the world means by “justice” today? What does it mean that God is just? How do these views of justice differ?
2. Read Hebrews 11:6. How does God desire for us to view him and to live a life of faith?
3. The main point for the message is: “A just life is lived believing God is just and holds us accountable.” In what ways does this statement reflect Hebrews 11:6?
4. Read Malachi 2:17. How have the people of Judah wearied the Lord?
5. Read Isaiah 5:20. In what ways has society called “evil good and good evil?” How have you called evil good and good evil?
6. Read Malachi 3:1-4. What is the promise in this passage?
7. Read John 1:6-7. How does this passage fulfill the promise in Malachi 3:1?
8. How ironic was it that the Lord mentioned “the Lord you are seeking” in verse Malachi 3:1 to a people who were not real faithful to God? How does this relate to the gospel?
9. Who can endure standing in the presence of a holy God (Malachi 3:2-4)? Why does the Lord purify his people rather than destroy them?
10. Read Malachi 3:5. Why are we to take care of the least of these? What are some ways we lack living out justice in our world today?
11. Why does God want us to fear him? How does the fear of God help us?
12. Read Luke 12:48. How does this passage apply to the Jews back then and us today?
13. What does it look like for you to live out justice and mercy?
