Easter at Westside: Palm Sunday Mark 11:1-11

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

John 2:24 (NIV): ²⁴ But Jesus would not entrust himself to them, for he knew all people.

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 11:1-3 (NIV): As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples, ² saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Until it and bring it here. ³ If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.'"

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

1 Samuel 6:7 (NIV): ⁷ "Now then, get a new cart ready, with two cows that have calved and have never been yoked."

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 11:4-6 (NIV): ⁴They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it, ⁵ some people standing there asked, "What are you doing, untying that colt?" ⁶They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go.

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 11:7-8 (NIV): ⁷ When they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it. ⁸ Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields.

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 11:9-10 (NIV): ⁹ Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!" "Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

Hosanna = "Save" or "Save us now"

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Zechariah 9:9 (NIV): ⁹ Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Mark 15:14 (NIV): ¹⁴ "Why? What crime has he committed?" asked Pilate. But they shouted all the louder, "Crucify him!"

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.

MAIN SCRIPTURE:

Mark 11:11 (NIV): ¹¹ Jesus entered Jerusalem and went into the temple courts. He looked around at everything, but since it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the Twelve.

SUPPORT SCRIPTURE:

Ezekiel 11:23 (NIV): ²³ The glory of the Lord went up from within the city and stopped above the mountain east of it.

MAIN POINT: Praise Jesus for who He is not for who you want Him to be.
