b) In verse 11, one guest did not have a wedding garment. What does the wedding garment represent/symbolize?

c) How does the response of the invited guests in the parable reflect the way people respond to God's offer of salvation today? What causes people to respond in this way?

3) Raise and discuss other captivating or complex issues you found while reading Matthew 19-23.
