Read Luke Chapters 7-12

1. Read Luke 7:40-50 (About forgiveness)

- a) Why is it difficult sometimes to forgive those who have wronged us?
- b) How has “being forgiven” and “forgiving others” impacted your life?

2. Luke 9:23-27.

- a) What does it mean for a person to deny oneself, take up the cross, and follow Jesus? (Luke 9:23-24)
- b) In which ways do we deny ourselves as Christians for the sake of Christ?

3. Read Luke 10:1-3.

- a) What do you understand by the word harvest and laborer/workers?
- b) In verse 3, what does the phrase “I send you out as lambs among wolves” signify?
- c) As Christians, what hinders us from bringing the harvest into the kingdom? How could we overcome the hindrances?

4. Read Luke 12:16-21 and Luke 15.

- a. What lessons do you learn from the parable of the rich fool?
- b. What is the central theme from these three parables in Luke 15 (Lost Sheep (v1), Lost Coin (v8), and Lost Son (v11))
