1. Ready Acts 19.

(a) Why do you think the seven sons of Sceva were overpowered and beaten by the man who had an evil spirit?

(b) Acts 19:18-19 says, "18 And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds. 19 Also, many of those who had practiced magic brought their scrolls together and burned them in the sight of all. And they counted up the value of them, and it totaled fifty thousand pieces of silver."

Discuss some things that Christians have to give up in order to take the cross of Jesus and follow him? Share your own experience as well.

2 a) Describe the significance of the miracle that happened in the upper room in Troas? (Acts 20: 7-12)

b) List and discuss the lessons you draw from Paul's exhortation to the Ephesian elders concerning preaching, integrity, humility, etc? (Acts 20:17-35).

3 a) Paul was warned twice not to go to Jerusalem for the Jews would have arrested him (Acts 21:4; 10-12)

b) Why do you think Paul used his testimony to make his defense after being arrested in Jerusalem? (Acts 22:1-21).

4 a) Why was there a great dissension between the Pharisees and the Sadducees to a point where the assembly was divided? (Acts 23:6-10)

b) How was Paul rescued from the plot that had been set up to kill him? (Acts 23:11-35). Has God ever rescued you from evil snares? Give a brief narration
