

A Letter from Esther Mwangi

Board of Directors; Director of Women's Ministries

It has been a great honor serving God in PIPES International since its inception in 2011. I have witnessed what God has done over the years through PIPES. It was a humble start in DR Congo, where there was a great need among the indigenous pygmy people due to harsh living conditions and neglect from the government.

One of the areas of my involvement was women's ministry. Women in Africa play a significant role in family stability and food provision, and therefore, efforts to empower women has significant outcomes. A significant area of concern was the hopelessness among women and families. We took considerable time to instill hope through God's word and looked at women's examples in the Bible. As a result, many women have given their lives to Christ and now have hope of eternal life and hope for a brighter future. Today, they take care of families, clean their children and the environment.

After several years of empowering indigenous women in Congo, we have expanded the work to other countries. This year alone, we have helped indigenous women in Africa start small businesses, assisted more than 200 families with farming technics and quality seeds, and trained women to treat and prevent jiggers menace among their children.

One of the most memorable trips was my first visit to Asia in 2018. We visited Indonesia, a country that has the largest Muslim population in the world. I led other women in conducting a women conference where we shared God's word and prayed with women. I have also traveled to Malaysia, Singapore, and South Korea. I have seen women become zealous for God amidst much persecution in the Muslim world.

We have also empowered women in Pakistan by training them on how to sew. More than 80 women have graduated from our training school, and 50 more are taking the sewing course. This has significantly improved the lives of women and families in general. Many women who depended on handouts can now provide for their families.

PIPES International started from a very humble beginning on October 31, 2011. We walked for miles searching for those in the forests of Congo, resettled families, build a school for their children, and shared the gospel of Jesus Christ. Today, we passionately continue to serve as a beacon of hope to the indigenous peoples worldwide.

This week we celebrate PIPES International's NINE years of God's faithfulness and favor. We celebrate NINE years of spiritual and economic transformation.

We are excited to see the tremendous growth of the HOPE ACADEMY. At the inception, we had NO building and only a few kids. The only thing we had was hope in the Almighty God. The student population then grew to over 600, and this month, our first grade 12 class has graduated. The nine students all passed their national exams, and they hope to join universities and colleges.

One of the most significant accomplishments in the last NINE years is to travel with mission teams to share the gospel around the world. From India's villages to the cities of Pakistan, towns in Indonesia, and the Africa forests. We've been to more than 20 countries declaring the gospel of Jesus Christ, and we have witnessed thousands come to Christ.

Today, with the Discipleship Pathway workbook, we are helping thousands grow in their faith and become faithful disciples of Christ. Paul in 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 says, "3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,". We have seen the message of the gospel changing lives in every sphere of life.

By God's grace, we have moved families from beggars to responsible citizens by supporting small businesses and helping with farming technics and providing quality seeds. We have relieved jigger infested children from severe pain and given deworming medication enabling them to walk and return to school. In everything we have done, we have demonstrated God's love. We continue to be the hands and feet of Jesus here on earth. We thank God for His favor and grace, and we thank all our partners for every part they played to make the achievements possible. As we start our 10th year, PIPES requests your partnership and continued support.

FIRST GRADE 12 CLASS JUST GRADUATED!

Education is a powerful tool for empowerment in Africa. The dream of educating the pygmies began in the year 2011 to help children who could otherwise not access quality education. We have achieved tremendous results for the last nine years.

The children who had never set foot in a classroom had a chance to acquire formal education. We began with a handful of children and one teacher. Today the school has more than 600 students from grades 1 to 12. This month of October, the first grade 12 class graduated after they all passed the national exams. They hope to join universities and colleges. Our ministry will continue to support their dreams, and we believe in building the future leaders of nations like Congo.
