INTRODUCTION

4 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons" Galatians4:4-5.(Fullness of time)

Christianity is unique because it stems from the uniqueness of Jesus Christ, the greatest man who ever lived. Matthew 2:1-7 (Wise men)

Readings: Matthew 28:18-20, Matthew 4:19, and Acts 1:8

- * The Birth of Jesus Christ and his early life. Matthew 1:18-25, Luke 2.
- * Discuss fulfillment of prophecies concerning the birth of Jesus (quote specific scriptures). (Virgin birth, Birthplace, Lineage of David)
- * Discuss the role of the wise men (astrologers) from the east- Matthew 2:1-7.
