LESSON 1: Moses and the Exodus.

Read Exodus chapters (1-3, 20-22) and Galatians 3:10-22.

Discussions:

- a) Moses and the Exodus story (Exodus 1-3)
- b) Introduction to the law and the role of the Priests in the old covenant (Exodus 20-22)
- c) The law and the promise (Galatians 3:10-24)
- d) How did God prepare Moses for the assignment of delivering Israel from Egypt?

LESSON 2: The Law and the Priests.

- a) Discuss the ten commandments-Exodus 20:1-7.
- b) What is the role of the Ten Commandments?
- c) Discuss the greatest commandment in the law, according to Matthew 22:36-40.
- d) How would you apply the Matthew 22:36-40 command to enhance our social cohesion in our society and nation today?
- e) What was the role of Priests in Israel?

LESSON 3: The Judges and the Kings.

Discussions:

- a) What was the role of the Judges, the Kings, and the Prophets in modeling the people of Israel?
- b) Before Saul, Israel had no king. How different was Israel from other nations that were ruled by Kings?

Lesson 4; The Prophets'

The prophets warned the people of their sinfulness and gave them the way forward. They were all used by God to fulfill the plan of salvation.

Examples of the prophets who predicted about Jesus are: Isaiah 7:14

(The virgin birth); Micah 5:2 (Bethlehem as the birthplace).
