CHAPTER 8: CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE:

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INTRODUCTION: THE TRINITY.

Read John 16:7-15, John 1:1-18

- a) WHAT do Christians refer to as TRINITY?
- b) DESCRIBE instances where the three persons are described in the same setting.

Remember the LORD our God, the LORD is one. Mark 12:29

TRIUNE GOD: GOD THE FATHER, GOD THE SON, AND GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT.

The doctrine of the Trinity holds that GOD IS ONE God, but three persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The three persons are distinct yet are one "substance, essence, or nature."

...... GOD SENT JESUS. GOD RAISED JESUS FROM THE DEAD.....

LESSON 1: GOD THE FATHER, and GOD THE SON

God the Father: First-person in the trinity. The creator of the world. Genesis 1:1.

God the Son: He was in the beginning and that He was with God and that He was God-John 1:1-2.

He gave up His privileges in heaven and came to earth to die for the sin of humanity.

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us-JOHN 1:14:


LESSON 2: THE HOLY SPIRIT

When Jesus Christ ascended, He promised His disciple a helper and even told them that it were better for Him to go for if He hadn't the helper would not have come. (John 16:7).

Acts 1:8 clearly stated that He gives power to believers to witness about Christ.

Acts 5:3-4: Ananias lied to the Holy Spirit...not lied to men but God.

- b) Discuss John 8:58 "Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM."
- c) Describe ways in which the Holy Spirit helps us in our daily lives.

- ii) Matthew 28: 19-20-Instructions on baptism (The father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit).
- iii) 2 Corinthians 13:14: Benediction-Grace of Jesus, Love of God, communion of the Holy Spirit.

Fruit of the Spirit-Reflect on the fruit of the holy spirt (Galatians 5: 22-23)

- 2. What do you believe about God, Scriptures, Humanity, Sin, Redemption, The Church,the world... things to come/Last things?
