TOPICAL VS EXPOSITORY [EXPOSITIONAL] <u>MESSAGE</u>

BOTH FORMS OF SERMONS MUST BE INLINE WITH THE WHOLE OF THE BIBLE

TOPICAL = SUBJECTS / DOCTRINE

LIMITED IN THE LONG TERM [ONLY SO MANY TOPICS]

PICK AND CHOSE, HOBBY HORSES

POWERFUL IF CALLED BY GOD TO USE

PRINT HOME WORK

EXPOSITORY = UNFOLDING THE WORD OF GOD FOR OTHERS TO UNDERSTAND GOD'S WORDS

IF WE CANNOT MAKE SENSE OF WHAT GOD IS SAYING WE HAVE NO BUSINESS TEACHING WHAT GOD SAYS WE WILL DO MORE HARM THEN GOOD

THIS DOESN'T MEAN WE DON'T TEACH THIS MEANS WE STUDY TO WE ARE ABLE TO TEACH 2 TIM 2:15

TEXTUAL MESSAGES = GRAMMAR, WORD STUDIES THESE NEED TO BE INVOLVED WITH BOTH FORMS OF MESSAGES

SERMON VS DEVOTIONAL

SERMON / MESSAGE = GOSPEL AND TEACHING

A DEVOTIONAL = A DOCTRINE THAT WE ARE TO DEVOTE OURSELVES TOO ONE SCRIPTURE AND EXPOUND ON THAT WITHOUT PROOF TEXTING KNOW WHAT WE ARE TALKING ABOUT WITHOUT A SERMON [BUILDS CREDITABILITY]

UPMOST FOR HIS HIGHEST, BOOK OF MYSTERIES

INTERPRETATION VS APPLICATION

BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION = GOD'S INTERPRETATION, NOT MAN'S COMMENTARIES, PASTORS, CHURCH, DENOMINATIONS, CHRISTIAN OR JEWISH UNDERSTANDING
THESE ARE HELPS NOT THE HOLY SPIRIT

THESE MAYBE RIGHT.....BUT YOU HAVE TO LET THE WORD AND THE HOLY

SPIRIT BRING YOU TO THAT CONVICTION AND CONCLUSION.....

NOT JUST JUMP ON THE BANDWAGON

ACTS 17:11

1] HOW DO WE GET GOD'S INTERPRETATION? PRAYER, LISTENING AND THE STUDY OF GOD'S WORD [WHICH IS THE HARDEST OF THE 3?]
THE LISTENING HAS TO BE CONFIRMED BY THE WORD AND VIS-VERSA SCRIPTURE INTERPRETS SCRIPTURE [EVEN THIS CAN BE TAKEN OUT OF IT'S CONTEXT]

2] CONTEXT VS CONTENT
CONTENT = THE WORDS ON THE PAGE
CONTEXT = BACKGROUND [WHO, WHERE, WHEN, WHY]
THE "HOW" = APPLICATION
WHAT IS THE CONTEXT OF 2 TIM 2:15

NO CONTEXT = NO UNDERSTANDING OF THE CONTENT.....WE CAN MAKE IT SAY
WHATEVER WE WANT IT TO SAY

3] WRONG INTERPRETATION WILL LEAD YOU TOO? WRONG APPLICATION "THIS IS DAY THAT THE LORD HAS MADE" PS 118:24 "COVER WITH YOUR ANGELS WINGS"

INFORMATION VS INCARNATION

INFORMATION = 1] facts provided or learned about something or someone.

2] What is conveyed or represented by a particular arrangement or sequence of things.

HOW DO WE AVOID INFORMATION OVERLOAD FOR OUR PEOPLE?

- 1] IMBALANCE: WE NEED THE INFO BUT TOO MUCH IS NEVER GOOD 70/30%
- 2] EXPOUNDING [70%] THE INFO [30%]
- 3] WHAT TO LEAVE OUT VS WHAT TO LEAVE IN
- 4] TO MUCH SCRIPTURE = TO MUCH EXPOUNDING = TO MUCH INFORMATION
- 5] TO MUCH SCRIPTURE = WITHOUT ENOUGH EXPOUNDING = TO MUCH INFORMATION

ROM 1:18-23 [WHAT TO EXPOUND ON?] TAKE 15MINS
HOW MANY SUBJECTS / TOPICS / DOCTRINES / CAN YOU FIND?
CHOSE YOUR LINE OF THOUGHT OR GO WITH THE OVERALL TEACHING?
MAIN POINT VS MINOR POINT EPH 5:22-32

PROOF TEXTING = MAKING SCRIPTURE AGREE WITH YOUR UNDERSTANDING "The 10 unfaithful spies suffered from low self-esteem because they felt like grasshoppers compared to the people in the land of Canaan.

DOES JESUS LOVE EVERYONE? PS 5:4-6, PS 11:5, HOSEA 9:15

For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

OTHER PEOPLE'S TEACHINGS

- 1] GIVE CREDIT WHERE CREDIT IS DUE
- 2] THEIR WORDS NOT GOD'S WORDS THIS IS HOW THEY SEE THIS
- 3] CAN BECOME VERY DRY FOR THE LISTENER WORDS ON THE PAGE
- 4] IF IT'S TRUE.....MAKING IT YOUR OWN

GIVE CREDIT, GOING INTO GOD'S WORD TO SEE IF IT'S TRUE, NO LONGER WORDS ON THE PAGE, NO LONGER DRY

THE INCARNATION OF THE WORD IS TO GIVE THE WORD LIFE THROUGH THE

HOLY SPIRIT'S UNDERSTANDING.....THIS ALSO REQUIRES THE GIFT OF

PROPHECY, TEACHING AND WORDS OF KNOWLEDGE & WISDOM

<u>PROPHECY = FORETELLING VS FORTH TELLING</u> 1 COR 14:1-19

VS 3 = 2 TIM 3:16

THE GOSPEL IS TO BE INCLUDED IN EVERY MESSAGE [PREACHING] BUT NOT

EVERY MESSAGE IS ABOUT THE GOSPEL [TEACHING].....EVERY MESSAGE DOES

NOT NEED AN ALTER CALL BUT EVERY MESSAGE NEEDS ATTENTION TO THE

CALLING TO THE ALTER

EMOTIONAL REACTION VS EMOTIONAL RESPONSE

EMOTIONAL REACTION = A REACTION TO WHAT WAS SHARED NOTING WRONG WITH THIS

EMOTIONAL RESPONSE = IS NEVER WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR
THE RESPONSE TO OUR MESSAGE SHOULD ALWAYS BE BASED ON THE
UNDERSTANDING OF WHAT HAS BEEN SAID NOT ON HOW SOMEONE FEELS
THIS UNDERSTANDING IS A COMBINATION OF THE WORD EXPOUNDED ON
PROPERLY AND THE CONVICTION BY THE HOLY SPIRIT OF THIS TRUTH
"CONVINCE THEM NOT TO BE SAVED" = UNDERSTANDING

THIS IS WHY WE NEED GOD'S INTERPRETATION OF HIS WORD NOT MAN'S
