SCRIPTURE READING: PROVERBS 1.1-9

- 1 The proverbs of Solomon, son of David, king of Israel:
- 2 To know wisdom and instruction,

in righteousness, justice, and equity;
  - 4 to give prudence to the simple,

- knowledge and discretion to the youth—
- 5 Let the wise hear and increase in learning,

the words of the wise and their riddles.
  - 7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge;

## PROCLAMATION

SCRIPTURE READING: MATTHEW 19.13-15

<sup>13</sup>Then children were brought to him that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples rebuked the people,  
<sup>14</sup>but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." <sup>15</sup>And he laid his hands on them and went away.

## EPHESIANS 5.15-6.4 (NASB)

<sup>15</sup> So then, be careful how you walk, not as unwise people but as wise, <sup>16</sup> making the most of your time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. <sup>18</sup> And do not get drunk with wine, in which there is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your hearts to the Lord; <sup>20</sup> always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to *our* God and Father; <sup>21</sup> and subject yourselves to one another in the <sup>b</sup>fear of Christ.

<sup>22</sup> Wives, *subject yourselves* to your own husbands, as to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup> But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

<sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, <sup>26</sup> so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, <sup>27</sup> that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> So husbands also ought to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; <sup>29</sup> for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also *does* the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are parts of His body. <sup>31</sup> FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND HIS MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH. <sup>32</sup> This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless, as for you individually, each *husband* is to love his own wife the same as himself, and the wife *must see to it* that she respects her husband.

<sup>1</sup> Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER (which is the first commandment with a promise), <sup>3</sup> SO THAT IT MAY TURN OUT WELL FOR YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.

<sup>4</sup> Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

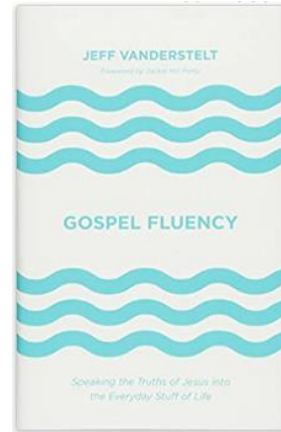
