

Prayer Liturgy – Week 2

- Pray through Psalm 34
Voice your own prayer of *thanksgiving* for God’s work in your life from Psalm 34.
Reflect on how you have tasted and seen that the Lord is good.
- Meditate on the following verse and offer a prayer of *confession*:
“I will endure discipline, for God is treating me as a son. For what son is not disciplined by his father? If I am without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then I am an illegitimate child and not a true son. Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us, and we respected them; how much more should I be subjected to the Father of spirits and live?” (Hebrews 12:7–9)
Ask the Spirit to *search your heart* and reveal any areas of unconfessed sin.
Acknowledge these to the Lord and *thank Him for His forgiveness*.
- *Intercession*:
 - Pray that God would bless you in your work/studies: to work in His strength and experience his presence in that vocation.
 - Pray for your family members: both your natural family and your spiritual family. Pray for those in need and pray for Godly unity.
 - Pray for a conflict or broken relationship that there would be forgiveness and reconciliation.
 - Pray for the leadership of our state and nation, both current and those to be elected.
- *Communal Prayer*:
“Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever,
For wisdom and power belong to Him.
He changes the times and the seasons;
He raises up kings and deposes them.
He gives wisdom to the wise
And knowledge to those who have understanding.
He reveals deep and hidden things;
He knows what is in the darkness,
And light dwells with Him.” (Daniel 2:20–22)
