

Prayer Liturgy – Week 1
Sunday, May 22, 2016

- Pray through Psalm 103
Voice your own prayer of *thanksgiving* and *praise* based on Psalm 103. Recall God’s kindness to you and your family.

- Meditate on the following verse and *confess* your sin before God:
“The Lord is in His holy temple;
The Lord is on His heavenly throne.
He observes the sons of men;
His eyes examine them.” (Psalm 11:4)

- *Intercession*
 - Pray for the Church in DeKalb: that God would lead us, provide for us, and use us for his purposes
 - Pray for a friend outside the Church with whom you would like to have a spiritual conversation: pray that God would use you to be a blessing in their life
 - Pray for pastor Jamie: for his family, his leadership, and his rest

- *Communal prayer:*
“Whom have I in heaven but You?
And there is nothing on earth I desire besides You.
My flesh and my heart may fail,
But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.
Those who are far from You will perish;
You have cut off all who are unfaithful to You.
But as for me, the nearness of God is my good.
I have made the Lord God my refuge,
That I may tell of all Your works.” (Psalm 73:25–28)
