Reaching out to those in darkness.

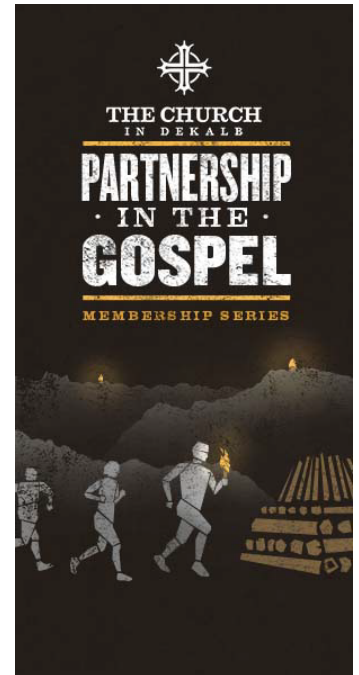
Our call to war, to love the captive soul,
