


WELCOME VISITORS!

The truth is, I will never be able to express in words the gratitude and joy I have in my heart for all of you! Paul said it better than I can say when he wrote to the Philippians, "For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus" (Phil. 1:8.)

It was devastating to learn Linda had Stage Four Breast Cancer and that is was wide spread throughout her bones. We simply had no idea it was as advanced or as aggressive as it turned out to be. A simple visit to the doctor for advice became a nine day stay in the hospital and her eventual death. We never thought that moment would come so soon.

You stood by us. You prayed for us. You love us. You missed us. At the some time you rose to the occasion. You made plans for ministry, you made the most of our situation to share the Good News of Jesus. You made our suffering worthwhile in someone's life! You made your pastor's heart overflow with love and gladness!

As grateful to and for all of you as I am for how you stepped up in love and honored God and exalted Christ in these last weeks, I urge you, as Paul did the Philippians and as Jesus urged His disciples, "Don't stop now!" Paul said it more like this:
