

CALL TO WORSHIP

Based on Psalm 135:1-6; Exodus 6:2-3, 6

PASTOR Praise the LORD!
Praise the name of the LORD — the
name he declared to Moses at the
burning bush, the name he swore to
Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: I am the
LORD.

PEOPLE *We come to worship
the God who keeps his covenant
and does not forget his people.*

MINISTER He is the LORD who
brought Israel out from under the
burdens of Egypt. He redeemed them
with an outstretched arm and with
great acts of judgment — not because
of their merit, but for the sake of his
name.

PEOPLE *He is the same God
today — great above all gods,
doing whatever he pleases in
heaven and on earth.*

MINISTER Come, then, and
worship him — not a god of our own
making, but the living God who has
revealed himself, who commands
kings, and who will take us as his own
people.

PEOPLE *We worship the LORD
— sovereign over all, faithful to
his word, and mighty to save.
Praise the LORD!*

The Name and the Promise

Isaiah 43:1–3, 10–11; Romans 9:15–16

The congregation reads responsively. Bold italic text is read by all.

MINISTER But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine." — Isaiah 43:1

PEOPLE *When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you. — Isaiah 43:2a*

MINISTER For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. — Isaiah 43:3a

PEOPLE *"You are my witnesses," declares the LORD, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he." — Isaiah 43:10a*

MINISTER Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me. I, I am the LORD, and besides me there is no savior. — Isaiah 43:10b–11

PEOPLE *For he says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion." So then it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God, who has mercy. — Romans 9:15–16*

ALL *To him who alone does great wonders — for his steadfast love endures forever! — Psalm 136:4*

Today's Scripture

Exodus 6:14-7:7 (ESV)

¹⁴ These are the heads of their fathers' houses: the sons of Reuben, the firstborn of Israel: Hanoch, Pallu, Hezron, and Carmi; these are the clans of Reuben. ¹⁵ The sons of Simeon: Jemuel, Jamin, Ohad, Jachin, Zohar, and Shaul, the son of a Canaanite woman; these are the clans of Simeon. ¹⁶ These are the names of the sons of Levi according to their generations: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari, the years of the life of Levi being 137 years. ¹⁷ The sons of Gershon: Libni and Shimei, by their clans. ¹⁸ The sons of Kohath: Amram, Izhar, Hebron, and Uzziel, the years of the life of Kohath being 133 years. ¹⁹ The sons of Merari: Mahli and Mushi. These are the clans of the Levites according to their generations. ²⁰ Amram took as his wife Jochebed his father's sister, and she bore him Aaron and Moses, the years of the life of Amram being 137 years. ²¹ The sons of Izhar: Korah, Nepheg, and Zichri. ²² The sons of Uzziel: Mishael, Elzaphan, and Sithri. ²³ Aaron took as his wife Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab and the sister of Nahshon, and she bore him Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. ²⁴ The sons of Korah: Assir, Elkanah, and Abiasaph; these are the clans of the Korahites. ²⁵ Eleazar, Aaron's son, took as his wife one of the daughters of Putiel, and she bore him Phinehas. These are the heads of the fathers' houses of the Levites by their clans.

²⁶ These are the Aaron and Moses to whom the LORD said: "Bring out the people of Israel from the land of Egypt by their hosts." ²⁷ It was they who spoke to Pharaoh king of Egypt about bringing out the people of Israel from Egypt, this Moses and this Aaron. ²⁸ On the day when the LORD spoke to Moses in the land of Egypt, ²⁹ the LORD said to Moses, "I am the LORD; tell Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say to you." ³⁰ But Moses said to the LORD, "Behold, I am of uncircumcised lips. How will Pharaoh listen to me?"

¹ And the LORD said to Moses, "See, I have made you like God to Pharaoh, and your brother Aaron shall be your prophet. ² You shall speak all that I command you, and your brother Aaron shall tell Pharaoh to let the people of Israel go out of his land. ³ But I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and though I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, ⁴ Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will lay my hand on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment. ⁵ The Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them." ⁶ Moses and Aaron did so; they did just as the LORD commanded them. ⁷ Now Moses was eighty years old, and Aaron eighty-three years old, when they spoke to Pharaoh.
