Scripture Passages Referenced

- Matthew 16:13 - Who do people say that the Son of Man is?
- Matthew 16:15 - But who do you say that I am?
- John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- Psalm 90:2 - Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.
- John 8:58 - Before Abraham was, I am.
- Isaiah 43:13 - Also, henceforth I am he...
- Acts 13:32-33 - And we bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus, as also it is written in the second Psalm, 'You are my Son, today I have begotten you.'

Discussion Questions

- When you think about the Lord Jesus, what thoughts immediately come to mind?
- Why do you think we often have too small a view of Jesus?
- How does Hebrews 1 help us have a bigger view of Jesus?
- What does it mean that Jesus is the eternally begotten Son of God?
- Why is it wrong (heretical) to say that Jesus was created?
- How does this help you discern the errors of some who call themselves Christians but are not (Mormons, Jehovah's Witness, etc.)?
- What impact does the truth that Jesus is the eternally begotten Son of God have on the gospel?
- What impact does the truth that Jesus is the eternally begotten Son of God have on your heart?
- How can these three truths give you peace?
- How can these three truths strengthen your faith?
- What does it mean to practically fix your eyes on Jesus?
- How does this passage and sermon grow your view of Jesus?
- How does this passage and sermon challenge you to love and worship Jesus more?
