

## ***“Freedom From Your Fears”***

*Isaiah 41:10 (KJV)* <sup>10</sup> *Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.*

### **The Fear Factor**

**Fear Whispers limitations, Not Facts:** it voices possibilities framed as inevitabilities. “What if you fail?” “What if they judge you?” “What if you’re not enough?” What if you loose it all.

**Fear Magnifies Uncertainties:** A small unknown becomes a looming catastrophe. A single risk becomes a guaranteed failure. Are you sure you want to risk it? Are you sure you want to go down that path. Remember how things turned out the last time.

**Fear Glorifies Retreat:** Fear convinces you that retreating is safer than possibility. It paints safety as virtue, even when safety sometimes is just stagnation dressed up as wisdom.

**Fear Sometimes Mask Itself As Caution:** What’s the hurry, Don’t get too far ahead of yourself.

- **Fear Is A Climate That Controls and Deprives You of Truth.**
- **You Must Choose What You Decide To Put Your Faith In.**

### **The Truth Fear Doesn’t Want You To Know.**

- Possibilities Always Outweigh Risk.
- Advancement Demands Courageous Action.
- Courage Isn’t The Absence Of Fear, But The Refusal To Let Fear Dictate Your Decision Making.
- Fear Is Not A Master, It Is A Messenger!

**Oppression: To Be Held Down Or Restricted By Unfair Power.**

Freedom from fear is not the absence of danger; it is the confidence you have that refuses to bow to intimidation because of who you have sustaining you.
